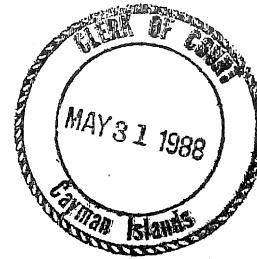

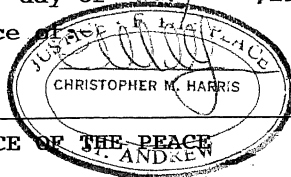
APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF PROBATE OF A WILL

- a) Within six months of the grant to us of Probate of the said **WILL** prepare a true Inventory of the said Estate and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- b) Within one year of such grant to us administer the said Estate according to the tenor of the **WILL** and the Directions, if any, of the Court and file in the Probate Registry a General accounting for the whole of the assets of the said Estate.
