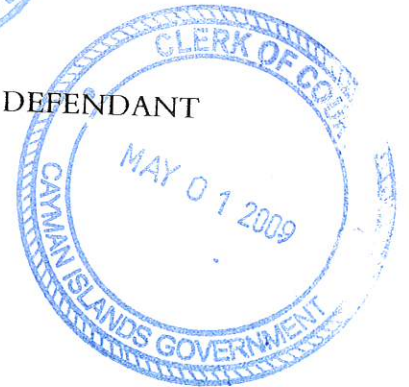

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE DEFENDANT of Maples Corporate Services Limited, Ugland House, PO Box 309, South Church Street, George Town Grand Cayman attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the _____ day of _____ 2009, at _____ o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff of Neptunusstraat 41 - 63, 2132 JA Hoofddorp, The Netherlands, for the following orders and other relief:


1. Hugh Dickson of Grant Thornton Specialist Services Cayman Ltd be appointed as Liquidator (the "Liquidator") of the Partnership forthwith.
2. The Liquidator be directed:
 - a. to wind up the affairs of the Partnership in accordance with mutatis mutandis the provisions of Article 10 of the Amended and Restated Partnership Agreement between inter alia the Plaintiff and Defendant appended hereto ("the Agreement"); and
 - b. insofar as consistent with Article 10 of the Agreement, to exercise the powers of a liquidator as set out in the Third Schedule of the Companies

Law, and that the said powers listed in Parts I and II of the Third Schedule (with the exception of item 5 of Part II of the Third Schedule) be exercisable without the sanction of the Court; and for this purpose a reference in the Third Schedule of the Companies Law to a company be deemed to mean a reference to the Partnership, and that a reference in the Third Schedule to a contributory be deemed to mean a reference to a Limited Partner;

3. The Defendant be restrained from parting with power, possession, custody or control of the assets of the Partnership, other than to the Liquidator, or otherwise transferring or dealing with the said assets and the Defendant be restrained from entering into any further or other investment commitments on behalf of the Partnership until further order of this Honourable Court.
4. It be declared that upon a true construction of the Agreement and in the events which have happened, no calls for capital contributions may be made or pursued under article 6 of the Agreement by the Defendant, and it be ordered that any extant or outstanding calls for capital contributions be annulled, alternatively be rescinded.
5. Alternatively, it be declared that any such calls for capital contributions may hereafter be made, pursued or alternatively rescinded only by authority of the Liquidator.
6. An order in any event that the Defendant, alternatively the Liquidator, be restrained from taking any steps, following the non-payment of any extant or outstanding calls for capital contributions, under article 6.3.2 of the Agreement (including but not limited to the delivery of a notice of default thereunder) until completion of the dissolution of the Partnership, alternatively until at least 10 business days after determination of the relief sought in paragraphs 5 and 6 above.
7. There be liberty to apply for such further or other relief as this Honourable Court may deem fit.
8. The costs of and occasioned by this application be paid by the Defendant.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts office by no later than Wednesday, 13 May 2009.
