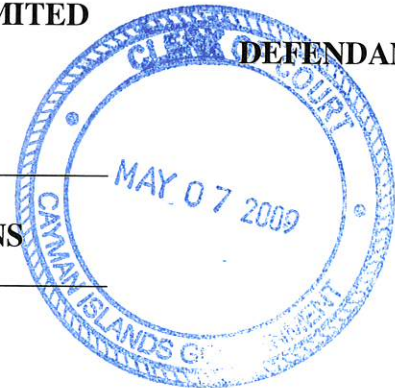

ORIGINATING SUMMONS



TO: Drawbridge Global Macro Fund Limited of Maples Corporate Services Limited, Ugland House, PO Box 309, South Church Street, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, British West Indies.

LET EACH OF THE DEFENDANTS, within 14 days after service of this Summons on it, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this Summons, which is issued on the application of Dorton Worldwide Limited and Caythorpe Holdings Limited, both of Omar Hodge Building, Wickhams Cay 1, PO Box 362, Road Town, Tortola, British Virgin Islands, the Plaintiffs seek declarations and orders that on a proper construction of the First Defendant's constitutional documents and pursuant to GCR Order 28, Rule 4(1) and Section 46 of the Companies Law (2007 Revision):

1. All of the shares held by each of the Plaintiffs in the First Defendant (the **Shares**) were effectively redeemed on 31 January 2009.

2. The First Defendant was and is only permitted to pay the redemption proceeds due to the Plaintiffs in respect of the effective redemption of the Shares in whole or in part by cash or in kind by the transfer of securities to the Plaintiffs, and if and to the extent that such payments are made by the transfer of securities to the Plaintiffs then those securities:
 - (a) must be securities which immediately before their transfer constituted part or all of the investment portfolios of Drawbridge Global Macro Intermediate Fund L.P. (the **Intermediate Fund**) and/or Drawbridge Global Macro Master Fund Limited (the **Master Fund**); and


 - (b) must not be securities which (i) derive their value from part or all of the investment portfolios of the Intermediate Fund and/or the Master Fund (as opposed to constituting part or all of those investment portfolios immediately before their transfer), and/or (ii) were issued, or were issued or otherwise created to be transferred (directly or indirectly), to the Plaintiffs (and/or other redeeming shareholders) for the purpose of purporting to pay the redemption proceeds due from the First Defendant to the Plaintiffs (and/or other redeeming shareholders), and/or (iii) may not be redeemed, transferred or otherwise disposed of by the Plaintiffs without the prior written consent of the First Defendant, the Second Defendant and/or their respective directors or agents.

3. The issue or transfer of shares in the Second Defendant to each of the Plaintiffs (the **SPV Shares**) in purported part payment of the redemption proceeds due from the First Defendant to the Plaintiffs was therefore ultra vires and void and/or did not otherwise satisfy the First Defendant's obligation to pay such redemption proceeds to the Plaintiffs.

4. The First Defendant therefore remains and is presently liable to pay the First Plaintiff the sum of US\$8,591,296 and the Second Plaintiff the sum of US\$7,939,001 in respect of the proceeds of the effective redemption of the Shares on 31 January 2009.
5. The register of members of the Second Defendant shall be rectified by removing the names of the Plaintiffs as the registered holders of the SPV Shares and registering the First Defendant as the registered holder of the SPV Shares.
6. Such further and / or alternative declarations and orders as the Court may think just and expedient.
7. Costs.

If a Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to it as the Court may think just and expedient.
