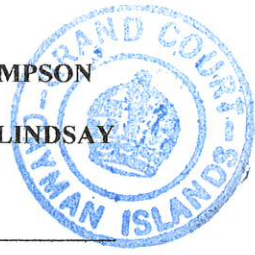
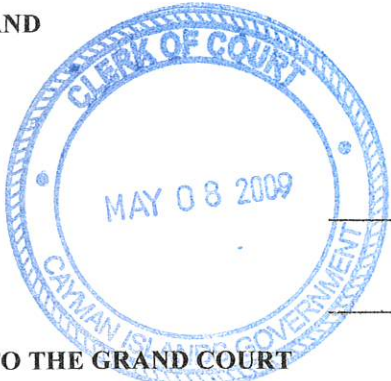

CREDITORS PETITION

TO THE GRAND COURT

THE PETITION of Royston John Barnard of Ohio in the United States of America, sheweth:

1. That Olney Thompson and Courtney Lindsay are jointly indebted to your petitioner in the sum of US\$35,000.00 evidenced by a judgment dated 3 February 2009 entered in favour of the Petitioner in Grand Court Cause No. 561/08.
2. That your petitioner doth not, nor doth any person or persons in his behalf, hold any security on the said estates of Olney Thompson or Courtney Lindsay, or on any part thereof, for the payment of the said sum, save for a dishonoured promissory note in the sum of US\$35,000.00 dated 30 March 2006 which is the subject of the aforesaid judgment and which security he will give up for the benefit of the creditors of Olney Thompson and Courtney Lindsay, in the event of their being adjudged bankrupts.
3. That the said Olney Thompson and Courtney Lindsay have committed acts of bankruptcy within six months before the presentation of this petition.
4. That the act of bankruptcy committed by them is that under s.14(h) of the Bankruptcy Law (1997 Revision), namely that the Petitioner on 3 February 2009 obtained final judgment in the sum of US\$35,000.00 against the said Olney Thompson and Courtney Lindsay jointly and severally in Grand Court Cause No. 561/08 and on 29 March 2009 served on each of them a Bankruptcy Notice dated 9 March 2009 in the form of Form 52 under the Grand Court (Bankruptcy) Rules requiring them to pay the judgment sum of US\$35,000.00 for which judgment was obtained and that the said Olney Thompson and Courtney Lindsay have not within seven days after service of the said bankruptcy notice, paid such amount, or secured or compounded for the same to the satisfaction of the Petitioner.

YOUR PETITIONER therefore prays that, on proof of the requisites in that behalf, on the hearing of this petition, the said Olney Thompson and Courtney Lindsay may be adjudged bankrupts.
