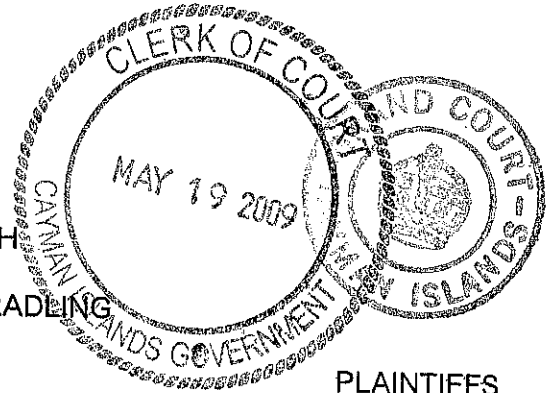

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiffs in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the

Plaintiffs may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

IMPORTANT

Directions for Acknowledgment of Service are given with the accompanying form.

The Plaintiffs' claim is for:

1. Specific performance of the First Defendant's obligations under agreements with the Plaintiffs for the sale and development of property located at a development known as "The Point at Paradise Cove" located at 68 Spinnaker Road (Block 22D Parcel 317);
2. A declaration that the First Defendant is not entitled to rescind the said agreements, and that notices sent to the Plaintiffs to this effect on or around 15 May 2009 were of no legal effect and are unenforceable;
3. A declaration that the Second Defendant did not have lawful authority to deliver the said notices purportedly on behalf of the First Defendant, and that any resolution purportedly passed by the Second Defendant to this effect was passed for an improper purpose and is liable to be set aside;
4. An order that the First and Second Defendants are jointly and severally liable for the Plaintiffs' costs of and occasioned by this action.
