

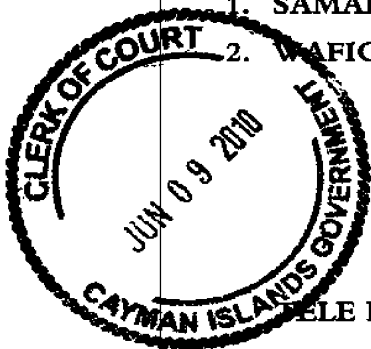

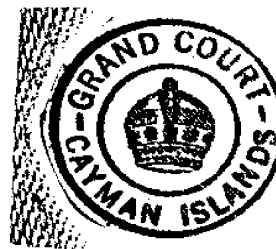

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiffs in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court office, PO Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman KY1-1106, Cayman Islands, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiffs may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Endorsement

The Plaintiffs' claims arise out of an express or constructive trust between Abdullah Saleh Kamel ("Kamel") and/or ~~the Defendant~~ Tele Invest Limited ("Tele Invest") and the First Plaintiff ("Samar") and/or Second Plaintiff ("Said") ~~(alternatively, an agency, sui generis contractual agreement, convention de prête-nom or société en participation between the parties arising variously under Cayman law, Syrian law or Lebanese law), and Tele Invest~~ the Defendant's knowing receipt of the trust property. The Plaintiffs claim:

1. A declaration that ~~the Defendant~~ Tele Invest (alternatively, Kamel through Tele Invest) holds certain shares in a company previously called Spacotel Syria now MTN Syria ("Spacotel"), in trust for ~~the First~~ Samar and/or ~~Second Plaintiff~~ Said, ~~alternatively for and on behalf of Samar and/or Said pursuant to an agency, sui generis contractual agreement, convention de prête-nom or société en participation (alternatively that Samar and/or Said is entitled to be registered as the owner of the same shares),~~ such shares totalling:
 - (a) 5% of the total issued shares in Spacotel, or alternatively;
 - (b) such proportion of the total issued shares in Spacotel that is an equivalent proportion to half of the shares acquired by ~~the Defendant~~ Tele Invest on its own behalf and on behalf of ~~the First~~ Samar and/or ~~Second Plaintiff~~ Said in 2002 (that is, excluding shares acquired by ~~the Defendant~~ Tele Invest on behalf of a prominent Saudi Arabian investor Prince Abdul Aziz), or alternatively;
 - (c) ~~such other proportion of the total issued shares in Spacotel as the Court finds were beneficially owned by Samar and/or Said, or such other~~ shares as the Court deems fit;


(the "Shares");
2. A declaration that ~~the First~~ Samar and/or ~~Second Plaintiff~~ Said are entitled to the dividends paid and payable in respect of the Shares and/or any proceeds from any sale of the Shares;

3. Damages for breach of trust, alternatively breach of agency, or contract, or *convention de prête-nom*, alternatively breach of duty under a *société en participation*;
4. An order that ~~the Defendant~~ Tele Invest and/or Kamel accounts for the value of the Shares, and any interest, dividends, profits and/or proceeds of sale;
5. Interest pursuant to section 34 of the *Judicature Law (2007 Revision)*, and regulations thereto, or alternatively pursuant to the inherent jurisdiction of the Court, at such rate and for such period as the Court deems fit; alternatively interest or further damages equivalent to interest under the Syrian Civil Code or Lebanese Code of Obligations and Contracts;
6. Costs; and
7. Such further and other relief as this Honourable Court deems fit.
