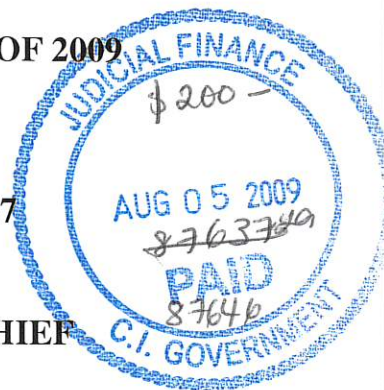
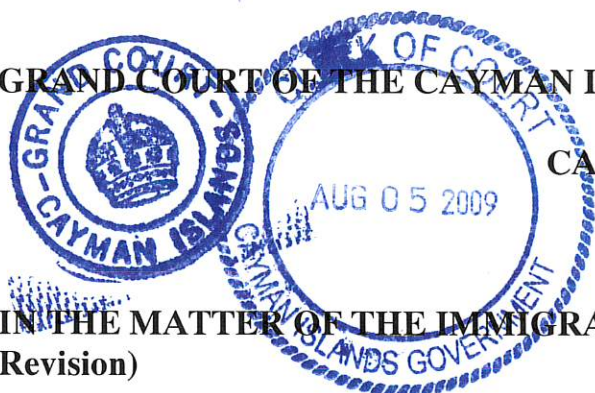

### GROUNDS ON WHICH RELIEF IS SOUGHT

1. The Acting Chief Immigration Officer unreasonably refused to grant extension to the dependent children Shawna-Kay Sayles and Daneal Barnaby pending an Appeal to the Immigration Appeal Tribunal from the Caymanian Status and Permanent Residency Board not to include them on the Permanent Residency and Employment Right Certificate for the Plaintiff, the Spouse of a Caymanian, namely Kenneth Stewart.
