DEFAULT JUDGMENT

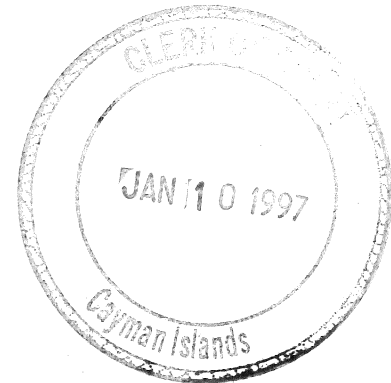
UPON reading the Plaintiff's application for default judgment dated 10 January, 1997.

AND UPON reading the affidavit of service of Joseph Bodden filed on 27 November, 1996.

AND no notice of intention to defend having been filed by the Defendant prior to the date of the Plaintiff's said application, the Defendant having made a partial payment of CI\$300.00 towards the amount claimed, it is this day adjudged that the Defendant do pay the Plaintiff the principal sum of CI\$11,534.94, interest thereon to 10 January, 1997, continuing interest at the rate of 14.25% per annum (6% above the Cayman Islands Base Rate) compounded monthly until payment and prescribed filing/bailiff fees and fixed costs of CI\$148.34 and CI\$500.00 respectively as claimed in the Writ of Summons.
