

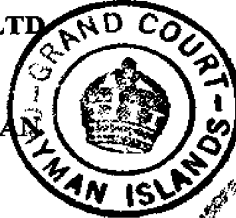

AMENDED ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Grand Court, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of 2005 at a.m./p.m. for the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff for the following orders and/or directions:


1. That the Respondent transfers all of the assets of the Makar Trust and the Nomad Trust (the "Trusts").
- 1A. That the funds held by Walkers pursuant to the Order dated 21st December 2005 be transferred in their entirety to the Applicant forthwith.
2. That the Respondent not be entitled to any further indemnity than that which they have already been provided with by the Applicant.
3. That the Respondent provides all documents relating to the Trusts which have not yet been provided ~~allows Mr. Mark Allison and a representative of the Applicant access to their premises in Bermuda for the purpose of inspecting and taking copies of the documents relating to the Trusts at a time convenient for all parties.~~

4. That the Respondent is not entitled to assert a lien over any of the Trust assets including the assets of the Nomad Trust which are currently held by AIG Life of Bermuda.
5. That the Respondent prepare accounts for the period from 1 January 2002 until the conclusion of their Trusteeship at no additional cost to the Trusts.
- 5A. That the Respondent account to the Applicant for all amounts that it has paid itself by way of fees and expenses and all amounts paid to its legal counsel from time to time throughout its tenure as Trustee.
6. That the Respondent pay the Applicant's costs of this Originating Summons.

AND LET THE RESPONDENT within 14 days after service of this Summons on him counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts Office.
