1. That the Applicant, Tania Connolly aka Tania E. Connolly, be appointed guardian for the said Jennie Amanda Fletcher aka Jennie Fletcher aka Jennie A. Fletcher (' the Patient') and over her estate and effects with the following powers conferred upon her.
 - (a) To control and manage any property of the Patient.
 - (b) To sell, acquire, charge or otherwise dispose of any property of the Patient.
 - (c) To invest the proceeds of sale or any other monies belonging to the Patient in such securities as the Applicant for the time being is authorized by law to invest.

- (d) To deposit into and withdraw from any account at any bank or lending institution in the Cayman Islands and elsewhere such of the Patient's monies as may be necessary for the proper maintenance and care of the Patient.
2. That the Applicant be appointed Receiver in relation to the administration of the estate or property of the Patient.
 3. That the Applicant shall keep proper accounts of the administration and management of the property of the Patient and whenever required by the Court to do so shall file in court copies of such accounts.
 4. That the cost of this application be paid from the estate of the Patient.
 5. That there be further and/or other relief as this Honourable Court deems fit and proper.
