LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (STUDENTS) REGULATIONS (2007 Revision)

Application to be Admitted as an Attorney-at-law

Section 3(1)(c) and regulation 15(2)

We, Martin Davies, of 302 Kisha South Church Street, George Town, Grand Cayman and, Philip Paschalides, of Walkers Attorneys-at-Law of 87 Mary Street, George Town, Grand Cayman do solemnly and sincerely declare as follows-

A. I the said, Martin Davies, for myself do say that -

(1) I am one and the same person named as clerk in the Articles of Clerkship bearing the date the 20th day of October 2008 now produced and shown to me marked with the letter "A".

(2) The said Articles of Clerkship were registered pursuant to regulation 18 on the 6th day of November 2008 with effect from the 20th day of October 2008.

(3) Since the date of execution of the Articles of Clerkship I have been actually employed in the proper business practice and employment of an Articled Clerk at Walkers under my Principal, Philip Paschalides, and have not held any other office or engaged in any other employment during that period.

(4) I have been convicted of criminal offences. The details of those offences are as follows: Disorderly conduct, date of conviction 1993, sentence CI\$100 fine, Failed to surrender to a bail condition, date of conviction 1999, sentence CI\$100 fine, Idle & disorderly person, date of conviction 1999, sentence CI\$250 fine, Threatening violence, date of conviction 1999, sentence CI\$500 fine. Pursuant to the Rehabilitation of Offenders Law (1998 Revision) these convictions are spent.

(5) I was awarded the Attorney-at-law Certificate on the 22nd day of March 2010, and a true copy of the same is now produced and shown to me marked with the letter "B".

B. And I the said Philip Paschalides for myself do say -

(1) I am a practising attorney-at-law qualified under section 16 of the Legal Practitioners Law (2007 Revision) to take a person into my service as an Articled Clerk, and am the same person named as principal in the Articles of Clerkship now produced and shown to me marked with the letter "A".



(3) The period of articles which has been served satisfies the requirement of regulation 15(1).
