

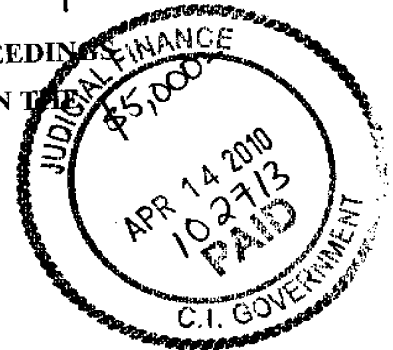

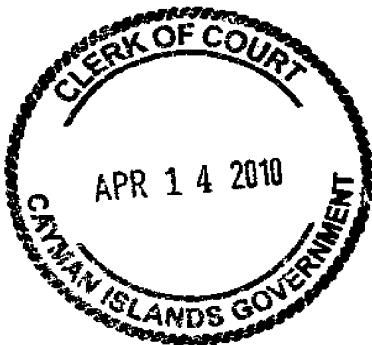



By this Summons, which is issued on the application of Branch Bank & Trust
Company, the Plaintiff claims against the Defendant an injunction restraining
the Defendant in the following terms:

1. That the Defendant be restrained from continuing or prosecuting or assisting in the prosecution of certain proceedings commenced or threatened to be commenced by the Defendant in the Supreme Court of the State of New York, County of New York or commencing any further or other proceedings in the Courts of the State of New York against the Plaintiff which are directed to obtaining an order for payment of the sum of US\$10,000,000 standing to the credit of the Fund in account number 414500121410 operated by the Plaintiff and which is the subject matter of the Writ of Summons in Cause No. FSD 83 of 2010 (the "Account Sums"), or for damages arising out of the Plaintiff's failure to pay the Account Sums to the Defendant or for interlocutory or injunctive relief in respect of the Account Sums;
2. That the Plaintiff be entitled to deduct its costs of and occasioned by the application from the Account Sums; and
3. That time for service of this Summons shall be abridged and the requirement for the Defendant to acknowledge service be dispensed with.
