

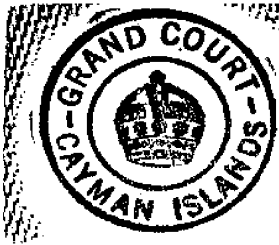

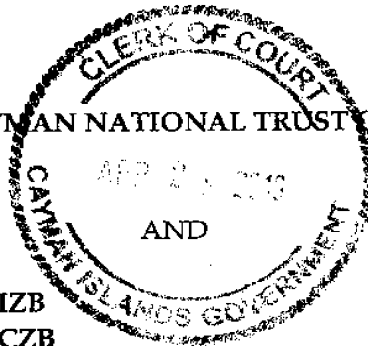

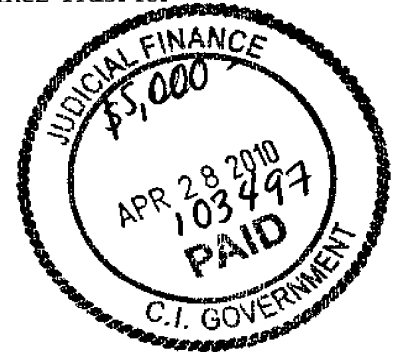

**BY THIS ORIGINATING SUMMONS** which is issued on the application of the Applicant CAYMAN NATIONAL TRUST CO. LTD of Suite 6201, 62 Forum Lane,

Camana Bay, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, who is trustee of the said Declaration of Trust ("the Settlement"), against the Respondents (whose addresses are given above and who are interested under the Settlement), the Applicant seeks the following relief:

1. Directions from the Court whether, in the circumstances described in an Affidavit to be sworn on behalf of the Applicant, the power contained in Clause 8.5 of the Settlement should be exercised by the Trustee in the manner contemplated in such Affidavit or whether some other and if so, what, steps ought to be taken by the Trustee in that regard;
2. If and so far as may be necessary, an order of the Court conferring upon the Trustee a like power to that contained in Clause 8.5 of the Settlement without the necessity of a Proper Instruction from the Technical Committee and/or the agreement of the Protector; and
3. Directions from the Court as to whether the Trustee should take any interim steps prior to the substantive hearing of the applications referred to at paragraphs (1) and (2) above;
4. An order that the Court file be closed to inspection by anyone other than the parties to the proceedings without the leave of the Court.
5. Such further or other directions as to the steps which the Trustee ought to take in the administration of the Settlement and such further relief as this Honourable Court deems appropriate.
6. An order making provision for the costs of this application.



**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SERVICE  
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of Acknowledgement of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Respondent or by the Respondent if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

1. Each Respondent (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Respondent personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Respondent is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Respondent is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.

6. Where the Respondent is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Respondent is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Respondent is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
