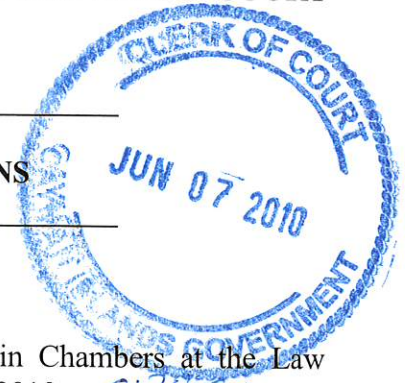

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2010 at 9:30 am/pm on the hearing of an application by CD Limited ("the Applicant") who is required by an order ("the Order") made in certain proceedings in the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands to provide copies of certain documents to the attorneys for the Plaintiff (XY) in those proceedings, for directions pursuant to Section 4 of the above-mentioned Law.


The Applicant is required by the order to give in evidence confidential information belonging to two companies with their registered offices at the Applicant's premises and such other parties connected to those companies to whom the Applicant either may or does owe duties of confidentiality by means of discovery of documents and seeks directions that

- 1) This Originating Summons shall not be served on any other party apart from the Attorney General
- 2) The Applicant has permission to anonymise this originating summons (as drawn) in order to comply with the terms the Order.
- 3) The Applicant may comply with the terms of the Order in its terms or as otherwise directed by this honourable Court.
- 4) The Court's file be closed and not open to inspection without the prior leave of the Court or until further order pursuant to GCR Order 63 rule 4.
- 5) That provision for the costs of this application be adjourned to the *inter partes* hearing of the Order or such other order in relation to the costs of this application as this honourable court thinks fit.

6) Such other orders or directions as this honourable Court thinks fit.
