

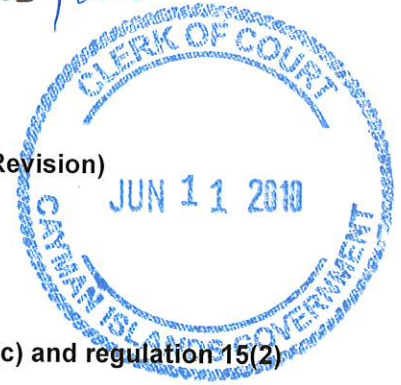

LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (STUDENTS) REGULATIONS (2007 Revision)

Application to be Admitted as an Attorney-at-law



Section 3(1)(c) and regulation 15(2)

We, Charlotte Cloete, of 32 Shoreway Town Homes, Adonis Drive, West Bay, Grand Cayman, Grand Cayman and, Vicki Hazelden, of Walkers Attorneys-at-Law of 87 Mary Street, George Town, Grand Cayman do solemnly and sincerely declare as follows-

A. I the said, Charlotte Cloete, for myself do say that -

- (1) I am one and the same person named as clerk in the Articles of Clerkship bearing the date the 2nd day of October 2008 under Nick Rogers (the "**Former Principal**") now produced and shown to me marked with the letter "A".
- (2) The said Articles of Clerkship were registered pursuant to regulation 16 on the 27th day of October 2008 with effect from the 1st day of September 2008.
- (3) On the 19th day of May 2009 I registered an Amendment to the Articles of Clerkship (the "**Amendment**") to extend my term of Articles of Clerkship until the 4th day of June 2010, to account for my scheduled absence from work for a period of four months due to maternity leave. This extension was required so as to comply with the required term of 18 months in accordance with regulation 15(1), such Amendment was registered with effect from 27th day of May 2009 and now produced and shown to me marked with the letter "B".
- (4) On the 27th day of January 2010 I registered a Transfer of the Articles of Clerkship (the "**Transfer**") pursuant to Section 18, from my Former Principal to Vicki Hazelden (the "**Current Principal**"). The Transfer was registered with effect from the 18th day of February 2010, and now produced and shown to me marked with the letter "C".
- (5) Since the date of execution of the Articles of Clerkship I have been actually employed in the proper business practice and employment of an Articled Clerk at Walkers first under my Former Principal, Nick Rogers and subsequently under my Current Principal Vicki Hazelden, and have not held any other office or engaged in any other employment during that period.
- (6) I have never been convicted of a criminal offence.
- (7) I was awarded the Attorney-at-law Certificate on the 8th day of June 2010, and a true copy of the same is now produced and shown to me marked with the letter "D".

B. And I the said Vicki Hazelden for myself do say -

- (1) I am a practising attorney-at-law qualified under section 16 of the Legal Practitioners Law (2007 Revision) to take a person into my service as an Articled Clerk, and am the same person named as principal in the Articles of Clerkship now produced and shown to me marked with the letter "A".
- (2) The said Charlotte Cloete has been bound by articles to me since the 27th day of January 2010, having previously been bound by articles to Nick Rogers since the 1st day of September

2008 and has since that date been actually employed in my proper business practice and employment as an Articled Clerk.

(3) The period of articles which has been served satisfies the requirement of regulation 15(1).

(4) The said Charlotte Cloete is a fit and proper person to be admitted as an attorney-at-law.

And we make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the Voluntary Declarations Law (1998 Revision).
