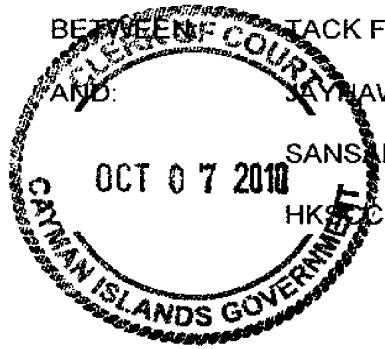

AND THE SECOND DEFENDANT of c/o 135 East 75th Street, 23rd Floor, New York, NY 10022

AND THE THIRD DEFENDANT of c/o 12th Floor, One International Finance Centre, 1 Harbour View Street, Central, Hong Kong

within 28 days after service of this Summons on him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office, PO Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this Summons, which is issued on the application by the Plaintiff of Century Yard, Cricket Square, Hutchins Drive, George Town, Grand Cayman, the Plaintiff seeks the following relief:

- 1. Declarations that the votes cast by the 1st Defendant and any party acting in concert with it through the 3rd Defendant at the extraordinary general meeting of the Plaintiff held on 15 September 2010 (the EGM) against the proposed Ordinary Resolutions

Numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 as set out in the notice of the EGM published on 31 August 2010, be set side and are void and of no effect.

2. Declarations that the votes cast by the 2nd Defendant and any party acting in concert with it through the 3rd Defendant at the extraordinary general meeting of the Plaintiff held on 15 September 2010 (the **EGM**) by voting against the proposed Ordinary Resolutions Numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 as set out in the notice of the EGM published on 31 August 2010, be set side and are void and of no effect.
3. Declarations that, as a result of the Orders in paragraphs 1 and 2 above, the proposed Ordinary Resolutions Numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 8 which were considered at the extraordinary general meeting of the Plaintiff held on 15 September 2010 were duly passed.
4. Such further or other orders as this Honourable Court deems just.

If a Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.
