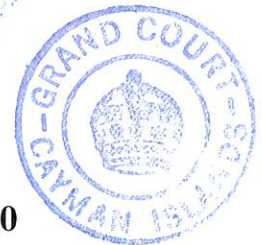

GROUND OF APPEAL

1. The immigration Appeals Tribunal did not give the Appellant an opportunity to respond to and to adequately put forward her Grounds of Appeal to The Tribunal omitted by her agent Cayman Immigration Consulting Services.
2. The Immigration Appeals Tribunal by rejecting The Appeal put forward to The Tribunal by the Appellant's agent Cayman Immigration Consulting

Services did not give the Appellant an adequate opportunity to present her case.


3. The Immigration Appeals Tribunal did not communicate its decision to the Applicant until 8 October 2010 thereby depriving the Appellant natural Justice.
