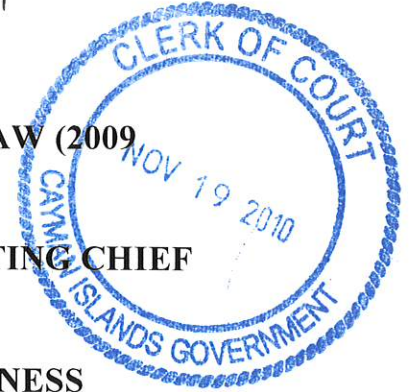


The Relief Sought

1. An Order of Certiorari to remove into this Honourable Court and to quash the decision of the Deputy Chief Immigration Officer and/or the Chief Immigration Officer and or the Immigration Department to send the Plaintiff Kireen Morris Holness out of the Cayman Islands pending the outcome of her Appeal to the Immigration Status and Permanent Residency Appeal Tribunal and her application to the Work Permit Board.
2. An Order of Mandamus directed to the Respondents requiring them to reconsider their decision according to the Law and to provide for the Applicant to make formal application for extension of time to remain in the Cayman Islands.
3. Interim relief in the form of an injunction pending the determination of this application and the appeal to the Immigration Appeal Tribunal, restraining the Deputy Chief Immigration Officer and/or the Chief Immigration Officer and or any servant or agent of the Immigration Department or the Respondent or any one of them from sending the Plaintiff Kireen Morris Holness out of the Cayman Islands, until these proceedings for Judicial Review and Appeal to the Immigration Appeal Tribunal and application to the Work Permit Board are heard and determined.
4. Cost of and incident to these Proceedings.
5. Such further on other Relief as the Court may determine is Just.

## GROUND ON WHICH RELIEF IS SOUGHT

1. The Facts.

The factual background to this application for leave for Judicial Review is contained in the Affidavit of Kireen Morris Holness that has been filed with this application and this Affidavit will be relied on in support of the application on the following grounds.

The Acting Chief Immigration Officer unreasonably refused to grant extension to Kireen Morris Holness pending her Appeal to the Immigration Appeal Tribunal from the Caymanian Status and Permanent Residency Board to Reinstatement the Permanent Residency and Employment Right Certificate to her, the Spouse of a Caymanian, namely Jeremy Holness, and her application to the Work Permit Board
