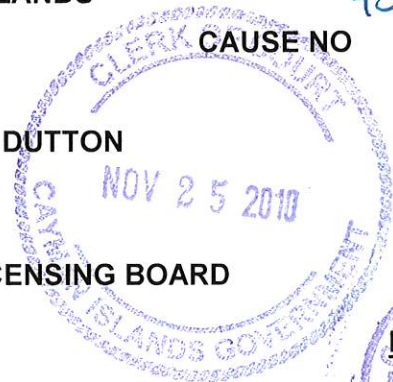


By this Summons, which is issued on the application of Peter Trevor Dutton, Managing Director of Jacques Scott Group Ltd, 384 Shedden Road, George Town, Grand Cayman, the Plaintiff seeks the following Orders:

- 1 A declaration that the Liquor Licensing Board ("**Board**") is bound by the email and letter dated 3 November 2010 written on behalf of the Board by the Government Legal Department/Attorney-General's chambers to the Plaintiff, which granted the Plaintiff's application to vary the location of package liquor license P-29-71 to a new location in a purpose-built store on West Bay Road near the Fosters Supermarket, and is estopped from acting inconsistently with the said letter.
- 2 A declaration that the Defendant's letter dated 19 November 2010 is invalid and of no effect, and should be immediately retracted.

- 3 Further and/or alternatively, an order requiring the Defendant to pay damages for losses suffered by the Plaintiff as a result of its reliance upon the letter of 3 November 2010.
- 4 Alternatively, leave to commence judicial review proceedings in respect of the Board's letter of 19 November 2010.
- 5 Such other orders, declarations or directions as the Court deems just or expedient.
- 6 Costs on an indemnity basis.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.
