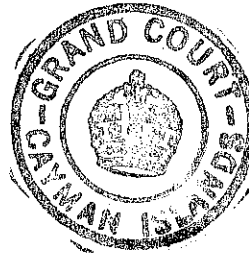

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 24th day of February 1997.

NOTE - This writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

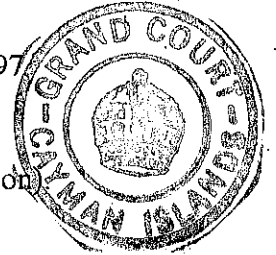
STATEMENT OF CLAIM



1. In or around 1992 the Plaintiff agreed to transfer land belonging to her and situated in Spotts Grand Cayman to the Defendant.
2. In consideration of the said transfer of land the Defendant agreed to discharge the loan that was secured against the land and in addition to pay the sum of CI \$3000.00 to the Plaintiff.
3. The Plaintiff duly transferred the said land to the Defendant who has failed to pay to the Plaintiff the said sum of CI \$3000.00 despite demands having been made for the same.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. The sum of CI \$3000.00.
2. Interest of CI \$1260.27 from the 1st of January 1992 to the 24th February 1997 continuing until Judgement or sooner at the daily rate of CI \$0.67.
3. Continuing interest pursuant to Section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 revision)
4. Costs.



If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgement of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of CI \$4,606.25 (including interest and costs) further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his Attorney.
