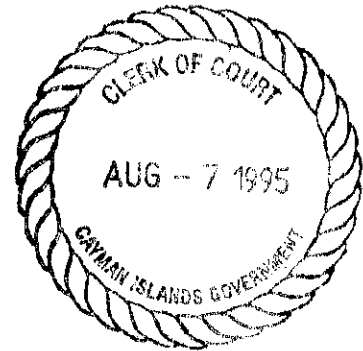
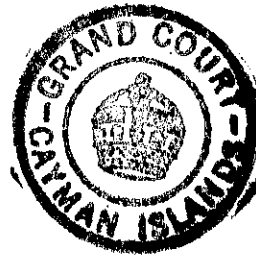

the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and Judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

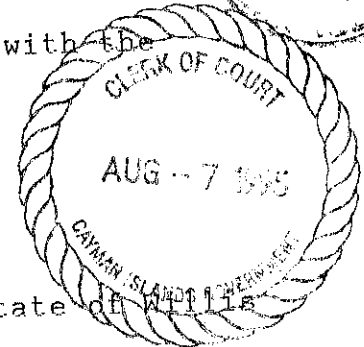
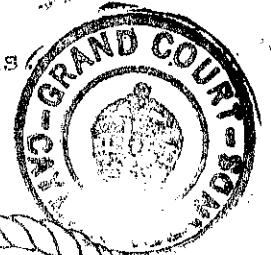

The Plaintiff's claim is as Administrator of the Estate of Willis Kenrick Ebanks, deceased against the Defendant for:

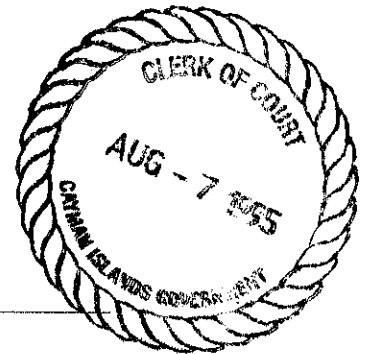
- (a) damages for the Dependants of the said Willis Kenrick Ebanks, under the Law of Torts Law (Revised) and

Caribe.

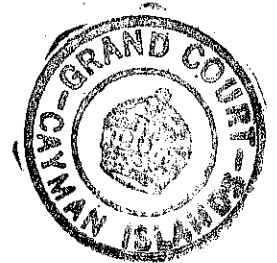
The Plaintiff also claims against the Defendant, interest on any amount recovered, by way of Damages and the Costs of and incidental to these proceedings.
