If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

The Plaintiff also claims interest thereon pursuant to section 34 of the Judicature Law (2007 Revision) on the amount found to be due to the Plaintiff at such rate and for such period as the Court thinks fit.
