

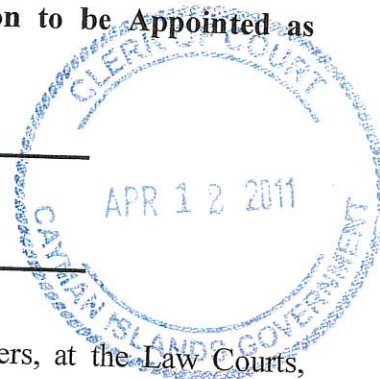

ORDER APPOINTING GUARDIAN

BEFORE Mr. Justice _____ in Chambers;

UPON hearing counsel for the Applicant and reading the documents in the court file;

AND UPON being satisfied concerning all necessary aspects of this application;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Pursuant to Section 14 of the Grand Court Law (2008 Revision), Shan Jennifer Harrison (“Shan”) shall with immediate effect be appointed to act as guardian of her husband, Gordon Reid Harrison (“Gordon”), he being a person of unsound mind and she being a fit and proper person to act as his guardian.
2. As guardian, Shan shall have the following duties and/or powers in relation to Gordon:
 - a. To do and secure the doing of all such things as appear necessary and/or desirable for his maintenance and/or benefit and for otherwise administering his personal affairs;
 - b. To ensure that he continues to receive the best care, supervision and control that is reasonably possible for his own protection and that of others;
 - c. To make such medical and/or other decisions for him as may be required from time to time concerning his mental and/or physical condition and/or welfare; and
 - d. To consult with such medical and/or other relevant professionals as may be necessary respecting his mental and/or physical condition and/or welfare.
