

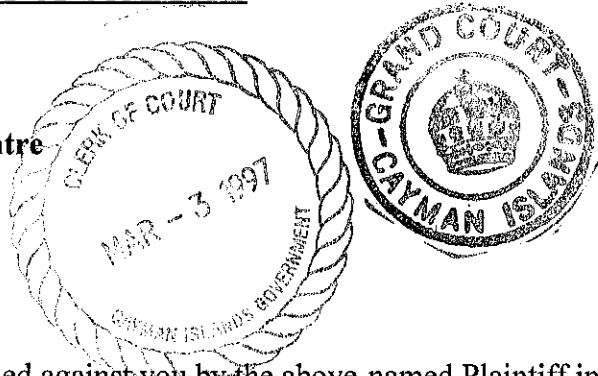

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within *14 days* after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this *3rd* day of *March* 1997.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (*or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months*) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

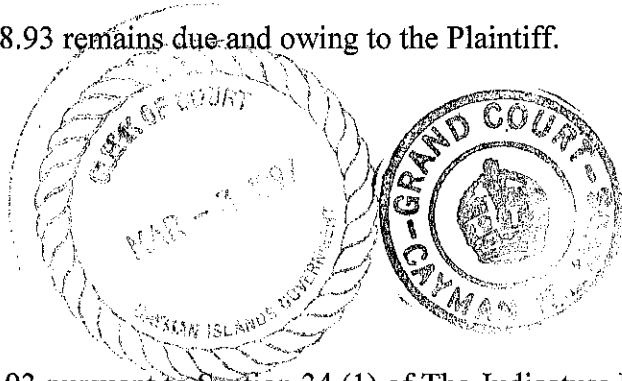

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. Pursuant to a Promissory Note dated the 16th February 1996 the Defendant promised to repay to the Plaintiff the sum of CI\$16,600.00 plus interest on demand.
2. By letter dated 17th October 1996 the Plaintiff made demand upon the Defendant.
3. Despite the aforesaid demand the Defendant has failed to pay the amount due and owing to the Plaintiff and the sum of CI\$17,368.93 remains due and owing to the Plaintiff.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:

1. The said sum of CI\$17,368.93.
2. Interest on the sum of CI\$17,368.93 pursuant to Section 34 (1) of The Judicature Law (1995 Revision) at 7 3/8% per annum being a daily rate of CI\$3.51 per day.
3. Costs.



If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of CI\$17,368.93 and CI\$500.00 and CI\$173.69 in respect of costs and fees respectively further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or its Attorney.
