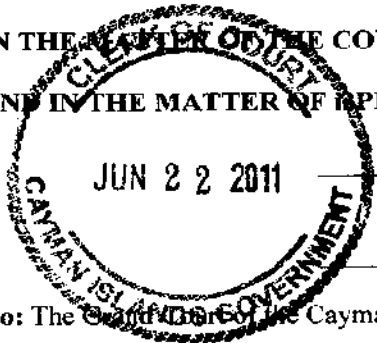

WINDING UP PETITION

To: The Grand Court of the Cayman Islands

THE HUMBLE PETITION of:

Delta Private Equity Partners, LLC (the "Petitioner") of 545 Fifth Avenue, Suite 300, New York, NY 10017, United States of America shows that:-

1. i2PF (hereinafter referred to as the "Company") is an Exempted Company, incorporated on 11 April 2007, under the laws of the Cayman Islands with registration number 185377.
2. The registered office of the Company is situated at Ogier Fiduciary Services (Cayman) Limited, 89 Nexus Way, Camana Bay, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
3. The Petitioner is a company incorporated under the laws of Delaware with its registered office at 545 Fifth Avenue, Suite 300, New York, NY 10017, United States of America.
4. Pursuant to a loan agreement dated the 30 July 2007 (the "Agreement") the sum of US\$200,000 was advanced to the Company with an interest rate of 8% per annum calculated on a daily basis.
5. As at the date of this Petition; pursuant to the terms of the Agreement the Company is indebted to the Petitioner in the sum of **US\$258,696.00**, inclusive of interest (the "Debt").
6. The Company has failed to satisfy its obligations under the Agreement and is in breach of its terms. Following these failures, the Petitioner served a statutory demand on Ogier Fiduciary Services (Cayman) Limited, the registered office of the Company, by personal service on May 24 2011. Despite the demand, the Company has not paid any of the above-mentioned monies.

The Company's inability to pay its debts

7. The Debt remains unpaid to date. The Petitioner does not hold security over any shares or assets of the Company in respect of the Debt.

8. In light of the failure of the Company to comply with the Petitioner's demands for payment outlined in paragraphs 4 to 6 above, the Company is unable to pay its debts as they fall due pursuant to s 92 (d) of the Companies Law (2010 Revision).

Conclusion

9. In the circumstances it is just and equitable that the Company should be wound up.
10. The Petitioner seeks the appointment of Graham Rawlinson and Peter Anderson both of Rawlinson & Hunter, Windward 1, Regatta Office Park, P.O. Box 897, West Bay Road, Grand Cayman, KY1-1103 will act as joint official liquidators of the Company (the "Liquidators"). Mr. Rawlinson and Mr. Anderson have both confirmed their consent to act as the Liquidators of the Company.

YOUR PETITIONER THEREFORE HUMBLY PRAYS THAT:-

- (1) The Company be wound up in accordance with the Companies Law (2010 Revision);
- (2) Mr. Graham Rawlinson and Peter Anderson of Rawlinson & Hunter, Windward 1, Regatta Office Park, P.O. Box 897, West Bay Road, Grand Cayman, KY1-1103 be appointed as joint official liquidators of the Company with power to act jointly and severally (the "Liquidators");
- (3) The Liquidators shall not be required to give security for their appointment;
- (4) The costs of and incidental to this Petition be paid forthwith from the assets of the Company on an indemnity basis; and
- (5) Such further or other relief be granted as the Court deems appropriate.
