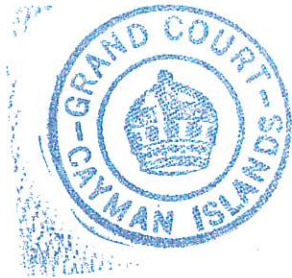


Originating Summons

LET THE DEFENDANT attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of July 2011, at o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff that an Order in the terms of the settlement agreed by the parties in the form of a draft consent order attached be approved and made an order of the Court and that by consent all proceedings be stayed for the purpose of carrying the terms into effect and that there be liberty to apply for that purpose.

DETAILS OF CLAIM

- 1 The Claim is for damages arising out of a fatal accident and is brought on behalf of a dependant, namely a daughter of the deceased,
- 2 The deceased, Maureen Bentick, died in University Hospital of the West Indies, Jamaica, on 28 March 2011 following a laparoscopic cholecystectomy procedure.
