The Relief Sought

1. An Order of Certiorari to remove into this Honourable Court and to quash the decision of the Chief Immigration Officer and/or the Deputy Chief Immigration Officer and or the Immigration Department to send the Plaintiff Patricia Ann Harrinanan out of the Cayman Islands pending the outcome of application for Judicial Review .
2. An Order of Mandamus directed to the Respondent's requiring them to reconsider their decision according to the Law and to provide for the Applicant to make further formal application to remain in the Cayman Islands.
3. Interim relief in the form of an injunction pending the determination of this application and any further formal application to remain in the Cayman Islands restraining the Chief Immigration Officer and/or the Deputy Chief Immigration Officer and/or any servant or agent of the Immigration Department or the Respondent or any of them from sending the Plaintiff Patricia Ann Harrinanan out of the Cayman Islands, until these proceedings for Judicial Review and any further formal application to remain in the Cayman Islands are heard and determined.
4. Such further on other Relief as the Court may determine is Just.

1. The Facts.
