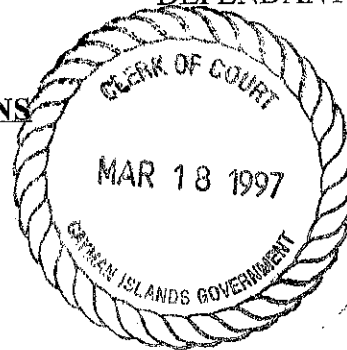

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

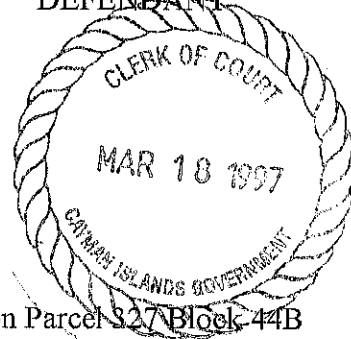

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. On the 5th day of October, 1996, at the plaintiff's house on Parcel 327 Block 44B in Bodden Town the defendant assaulted and beat the plaintiff by striking with a bottle, a knife, an telephone and his hand on her back, shoulder, head and neck.
2. Again on the 17th January, 1997 at about 7:30 p.m. at the security room at the George Town Hospital the defendant assaulted and stabbed the plaintiff three times, twice on her arm and once on her shoulder.
3. By reason of the matters aforesaid, the plaintiff suffered pain and injury, loss and damage.

PARTICULARS OF INJURIES

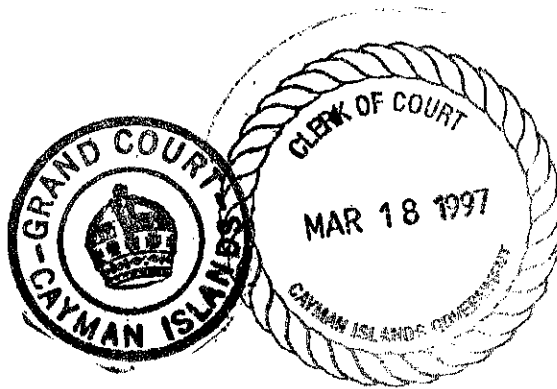
1. Bruises to the back, shoulder, arm, head and neck.
