ORDER

UPON the ex parte application by summons dated 30 July 2012 of Saad Investments Company Limited (in Official Liquidation) ("**the Plaintiff**")

AND UPON hearing Leading Counsel for the Plaintiff

AND UPON READING the First Affidavit of Stephen John Akers in these proceedings, sworn on 10 October 2012, and exhibit SJA-1 thereto ("**the First Affidavit of Mr Akers**")

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Plaintiff has leave to serve a sealed copy of the Writ of Summons in this action ("**the Writ**") on the Defendant outside the jurisdiction pursuant to GCR Order 11, rule 1(1)(ff).
2. Service of the Writ:
  - (a) by way of hand delivery to Appleby (Cayman) Ltd, Clifton House, 75 Fort Street, George Town, PO Box 190, Grand Cayman, KY1-1104, Cayman Islands;
  - (b) by way of courier to Saad Trading Contracting & Financial Services Company, Salahuddin Al-Ayoubi Street, P.O. Box 3250, Al Khobar 31952, Saudi Arabia; and
  - (c) by way of hand delivery to Harbottle & Lewis LLP, 14 Hanover Square, London W1S 1HP, United Kingdom,

shall be deemed to be good and sufficient service of the Writ on the Defendant pursuant to GCR Order 65, rule 4, and service shall be deemed to have been effected on the date on which delivery is made pursuant to paragraph 2(a) above.

3. Service by the Plaintiff of any other document, pleading, notice or order in this action by the methods set out in paragraph 2 above shall be deemed to be good and sufficient service on the Defendant pursuant to GCR Order 65, rule 4, and service shall be deemed to have been effected on the date on which delivery is made pursuant to paragraph 2(a) above.
4. At the same time as service of the Writ pursuant to paragraphs 1 and 2 above, the Plaintiff shall serve the Defendant, by the same means, with copies of:
  - (i) The Ex Parte Application dated 30 July 2010;
  - (ii) The Statement of Claim dated 12 October 2012;
  - (iii) The First Affidavit of Mr Akers;
  - (iv) The Skeleton Argument of the Plaintiff;
  - (v) The Plaintiff's attorneys' note of the ex parte hearing on 22 and 23 October 2012;
  - (vi) This Order and the Order made herein pursuant to GCR Orders 24 and 63.
5. The Defendant shall have 35 days from the date on which service of the Writ is deemed to have taken place hereunder within which to file an Acknowledgement of Service.
6. Costs reserved.
