EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before a Judge in Chambers, at the Law
Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of 2012 at 9:30 o'clock
in the forenoon on the hearing of an application by the Applicants, who seek the
determination of the Court on the following questions, namely an Order:

1. That the First Applicant be appointed guardian of the said Vivia Jen Farrington
("the Patient") and over her estate and effects with the following power conferred
upon him:
 - a. To control and manage any property of the Patient;
 - b. To sell, acquire, charge or otherwise dispose of or deal with any property
of the Patient;
 - c. To invest the proceeds of sale or any other monies belonging to the
Patient in such securities as the First Applicant for the time being
authorised by law to invest trust funds; and
 - d. To deposit into and withdraw from any account at any bank or lending
institution in the Cayman Islands and elsewhere such of the Patient's
monies as may be necessary for the proper maintenance and care of the
Patient.

2. The First Applicant shall keep proper accounts of the administration and management of the property of the Patient and whenever required by the Court to do so shall file in Court copies of such accounts.
3. That the Second Applicant also be appointed as the guardian of the said Vivia Jen Farrington ('the Patient') and over her estate and effects with the following power conferred upon him, upon the death or mental incapacity of the First Guardian:
 - a. To control and manage any property of the Patient;
 - b. To sell, acquire, charge or otherwise dispose of or deal with any property of the Patient;
 - c. To invest the proceeds of sale or any other monies belonging to the Patient in such securities as the First Applicant for the time being authorised by law to invest trust funds; and
 - d. To deposit into and withdraw from any account at any bank or lending institution in the Cayman Islands and elsewhere such of the Patient's monies as may be necessary for the proper maintenance and care of the Patient.
4. The cost of this application and the cost of the guardian incidental to and consequent upon the Order shall be paid from the estate and property of the Patient.
