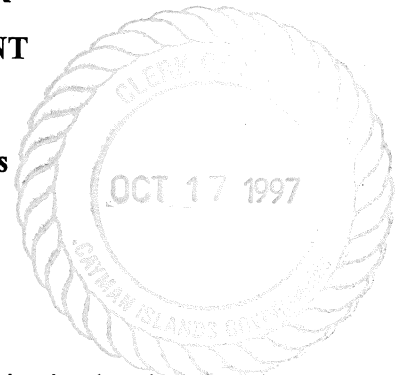

ORDER

UPON THIS MATTER coming on before the Honourable Chief Justice in chambers on the 5th December, 1996 AND UPON hearing counsel for the Petitioner and counsel for the Respondent AND UPON reading the affidavits of the Petitioner and the Respondent filed herein, it is hereby ordered:-

1. That the Petitioner shall have custody, care and control of the two children of the marriage, namely, ADIRA KELLY, born on the 12th February, 1982, and, DARREN KELLY, born on the 27th November, 1985, with reasonable access being afforded to the Respondent. Such access to be agreed between the parties. In the absence of reasonable agreement to be defined by the court.
2. That the Respondent shall pay the sum of CI\$550.00 per month by way of maintenance for the two children of the marriage.
3. That the arrears owed by the Respondent under the Order of Mr Justice Smellie, made on the 24th January, 1996, shall be paid off in the sum of CI\$100.00 per month.
4. The said maintenance and arrears are to be paid through the Court Funds Office,

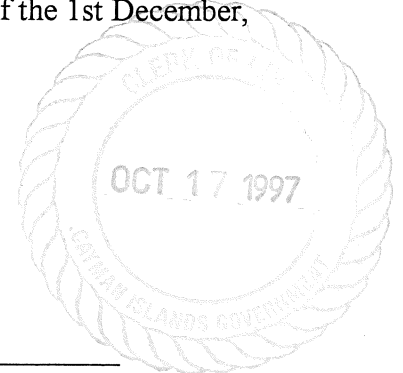


Treasury Department, Government Administration Building, George Town, Grand Cayman.

5. That the Petitioner and the Respondent shall each pay 1/2 of the educational, medical, dental and optical expenses in relation to the said two children of the marriage until they reach the age of 16 years or end of formal education whichever is the latter.
6. That the beneficial interest of the Petitioner in the former matrimonial home located at Lower Valley Block 48C, Parcel 41, is assessed at 40%. The Petitioner is hereby entitled to 40% of the equity of the matrimonial home and furnishings therein by lump sum payment. The value of the furnishings is assessed at CI\$3,000.00.
7. That the Respondent is given leave to present a current valuation of the matrimonial home within 30 days of the date hereof. If no valuation is forthcoming the estimated value of the former matrimonial home of CI\$250,000.00 shall be accepted.
8. That the Summons shall be set down for review during the week of the 1st December, 1997.
