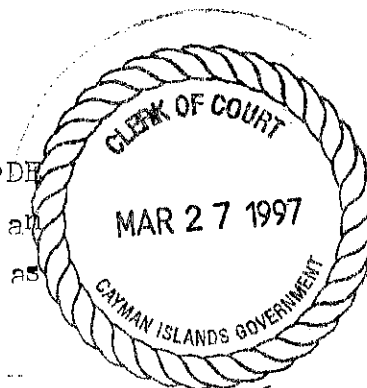

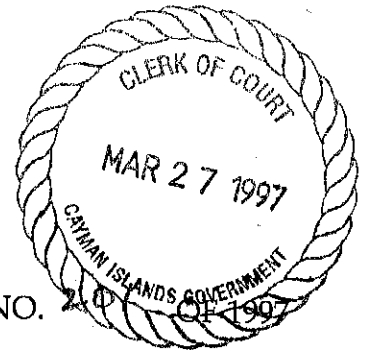

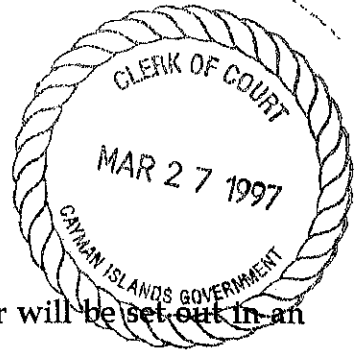


APPLICATION TO REVERSE THE JOINT OFFICIAL LIQUIDATORS

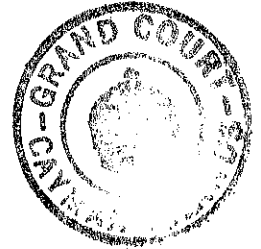
AND that the said Joint Official Liquidator may be ordered to pay the costs of and incidental to this application.
