Section 3(1)(c) and Regulation 15(2)

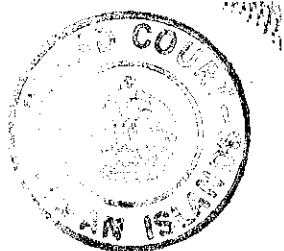
We, Tracey Touhey and Neil Lupton of Walkers, Attorneys-at-Law, Walker House, 87 Mary Street, George Town, Grand Cayman KY1-9001, Cayman Islands do solemnly and sincerely declare as follows:-

A. And I the said Tracey Touhey for myself do say that:-

- (1) I am one and the same person named as Clerk in the Articles of Clerkship bearing the date 16th day of September 2010 with effect from the 6th day of September 2010 with Neil Lupton now produced and shown to me marked with the letter "A".
- (2) The said Articles of Clerkship were registered pursuant to Regulation 17 of the Legal Practitioners (Students) Regulations (As Revised) on the 9th day of November 2010 with effect from the 6th day of September 2010.

- (2) The said Tracey Touhey has been bound by articles to me since the 6th day of September 2010 and has since that date been actually employed in my proper business practice and employment as an articulated clerk.
- (3) The period of articles which has been served under myself satisfies the requirement of Regulation 17.
- (4) The said Tracey Touhey is a fit and proper person to be admitted as an attorney-at-law.
