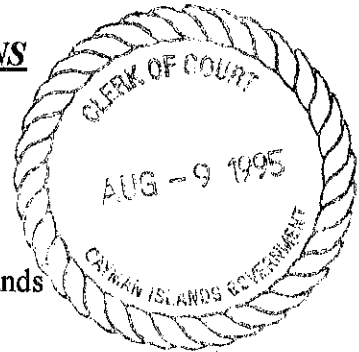

Within 28 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

The Plaintiff's claim is for CI\$15,750.00 being the amount due and owing to the Plaintiff by the Defendant under a written contract dated the 2nd day of December 1993 (a copy of which is annexed hereto) plus costs and interest.


PARTICULARS

On or about the 2nd day of December 1993 the Plaintiff loaned to the Defendant the sum of CI\$10,500.00 which the Defendant, by way of a written agreement on the said date, agreed to repay with interest of CI\$5,250.00 on or about the 4th day of January 1994 but has failed so to do despite repeated demands from the Plaintiff for the Defendant to fulfill her said obligations.

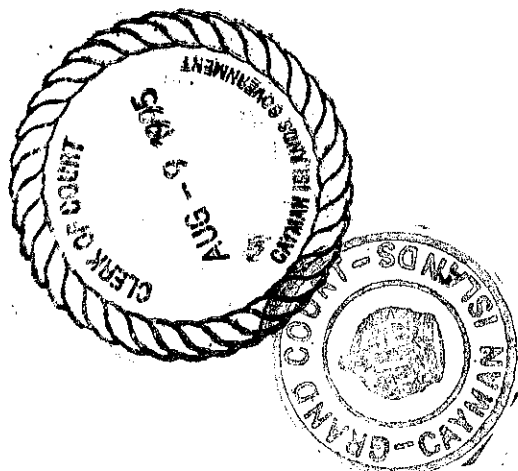
AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. The said sum of CI\$15,750.00
2. Interest at the rate of 8 3/8 % from the 4th January 1994 to date of payment of Judgment
3. Costs

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of CI\$17,359.75 (including interest and costs) further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his Attorney.
