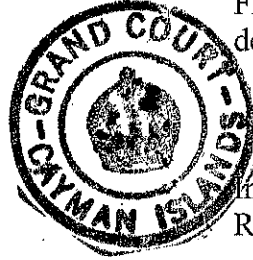

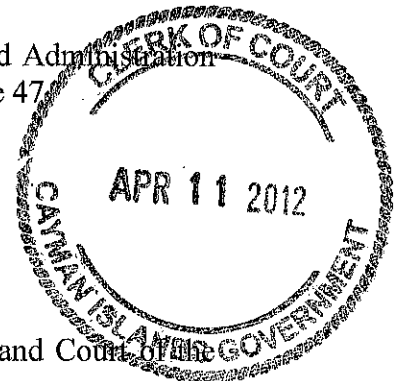




**SUMMONS FOR LEAVE TO SWEAR DEATH**
