LET THE RESPONDENT of P.O. Box 10344, #62 Amity Street, Grand Cayman, KY1-1003 attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the _____ day of _____ 2012, at o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Applicants of for the following orders:

- (1) That the Applicants be granted temporary/interim guardianship of Raquel Miranda Sara Brown.
- (2) That the Applicants may act, singly or jointly, for and behalf of Raquel Miranda Sara Brown solely for the purposes of providing the required consent for and on behalf of Raquel Miranda Sara Brown in relation to the open heart surgery scheduled for 24-25 April 2012 at Miami Children's Hospital and or any rescheduling thereof.

- (3) That the Applicants may act, singly or jointly, for and behalf of Raquel Miranda Sara Brown solely for the purposes of providing the required consent for and on behalf of Raquel Miranda Sara Brown in relation to the open heart surgery scheduled for 24-25 April 2012 at Miami Children's Hospital in relation to any and all follow up medical procedures which may become necessary in the future.
- (4) That the Applicants may act, singly or jointly, for and on behalf of Miranda Sara Brown, in relation to any and all medical treatment which is required to be performed by any other medical facility in the continental United States.
- (5) That the Applicants be permitted to sign, either singly or jointly, any and all documents necessary to accomplish the purposes set out in paragraphs (2) and (3) and (4) above.
- (6) That this Order remain in force for a period of one (1) year.
- (7) That there be liberty to apply.

AND LET THE RESPONDENT within fourteen (14) days after service of this Summons on her, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office.
