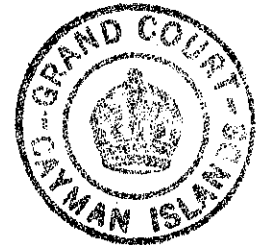

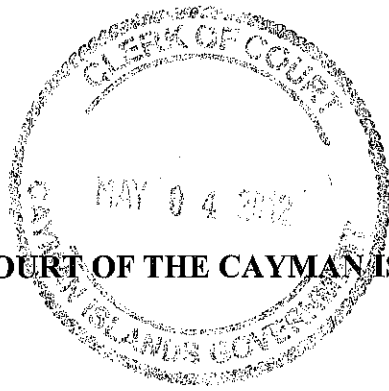

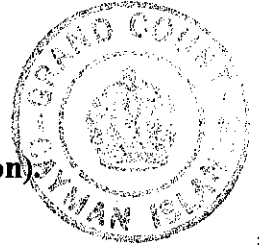

AFFIDAVIT

I, MICHAEL VINCENT WINGRAVE of 58 Mary Street, Unit # 8, F&J Centre, Grand Cayman MAKE OATH and SAY as follows:-

1. I was awarded a Second Class Honours (Upper Division) Degree in Law (LLB Hons) on 29th June 2001. Exhibited hereto and marked "MW - 1" is a true copy of the said Degree certificate. The degree course that I completed is unique in that it is the only course in England and Wales in which the Bar Vocational Course is included within an undergraduate Law course. The course takes four years to complete, rather than the usual three, and one is awarded one certificate for both elements of the course "MW - 1". The first two years of the course are academic in nature and the second two combine academics and the elements of the Bar Vocational Course. The Bar Council of England and Wales recognizes that the form and content of the course meets all necessary requirements of the Bar Vocational Course in England and Wales.
2. I became a member of the Middle Temple in August 1999, before I began the second two year portion of my Degree, during which I undertook the Bar Vocational Course elements of it. I was Called to the Bar by the Middle Temple in July 2001.
3. After I was Called, but prior to pupillage, I took a position with Irwin Mitchell Solicitors, a practice based in Birmingham (UK). I held a position there dealing with serious personal injury/neurotrauma and clinical negligence work, under the Partner heading personal injury in the Birmingham office of that firm, which is recognized consistently as leading in the Legal 500 and Chambers and Partners (UK).
4. I began pupillage in November 2002 at Durham Barristers' Chambers, and remained there as a tenant after completing pupillage at the same, until July 2005.

My practice was that of a true common law practitioner at that time, undertaking a range of civil, chancery, commercial and criminal matters.

5. In July 2005 I moved to No.5 Chambers, a set consistently ranked as leading in the Legal 500 and Chambers & Partners (UK) in various areas of law, deciding to concentrate exclusively in civil work, in contract and general commercial litigation under instruction from various firms of solicitors. I have experience in the County Court, High Court (both Chancery and Queen's Bench Divisions) and the Court of Appeal. I have acted for both individuals and corporate clients.
6. To date I have continually practiced as a Barrister in civil and commercial law. Exhibited and marked "MW-2" is a true copy of my Certificate of Good Standing from the Bar Council and exhibited and marked "MW-3" is a true copy of my Practising Certificate for 2011 - 2012 issued by the General Council of the Bar of England & Wales.
7. I am the holder of a Temporary Work Permit, entitling me to work in the Cayman Islands until 25th July 2012. Exhibited hereto and marked "MW-4" is a true copy of my Temporary Work Permit.
8. My employer, Stenning & Associates, Attorneys-at-Law, intends to apply for a full work permit on my behalf. Exhibited hereto and marked "MW-5" is a letter from Stenning & Associates dated 3rd May 2012 stating the same.

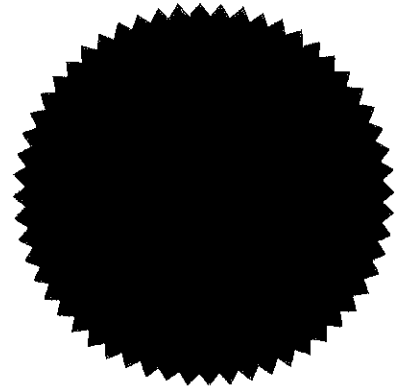


