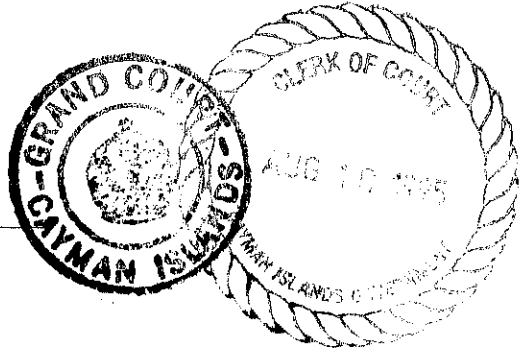
EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS
