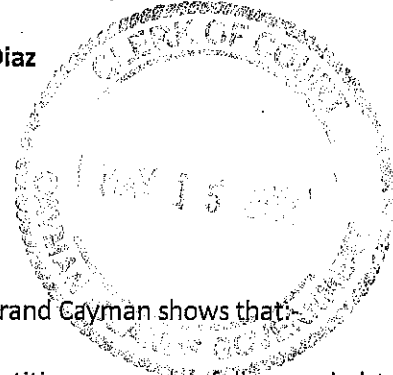

To the Grand Court

The humble petition of Sherlena Elizabeth Wright, 48 Casper Walk, Grand Cayman shows that:


1. On 4<sup>th</sup> August 2000 in Ciego de Avila, Cuba the above Petitioner was lawfully married to the above Respondent and at the time of the said marriage, the marital status of the parties was as follows:  
  
The Petitioner was a Spinster  
The Respondent was a Bachelor
2. Following the celebration of the said marriage, the parties have never cohabited and the marriage was never consummated.
3. The Court has jurisdiction in the above cause by reason that the Petitioner is domiciled in the Cayman Islands.
4. On or about the 11<sup>th</sup> of August 2000 the Respondent was detained by Immigration whilst entering the Country.
5. The Respondent has been continuously absent from the Petitioner for in excess of 7 years and the last time the Petitioner saw the Respondent was on 11<sup>th</sup> August 2000.
6. The Petitioner has attempted to contact the Respondent's family in the intervening period but has been unable to obtain any information that the Respondent is alive.
7. That the Petitioner has no reason to believe that the other party has been living within that time.
8. There are no matrimonial assets of the parties and the Petitioner does not seek financial provision, periodic payments, damages or costs.
9. That there are no and there have been no previous proceedings inside or outside of the Courts of the Cayman Islands in respect of the said marriage, between the parties.

Your Petitioner therefore humbly prays that:-

1. The Court grant a presumption of death of the said Amado Pardo Diaz.
