ORDER

THE COURT having directed that the Summonses to set aside and/or vary the ex parte Orders of the Hon, Chief Justice of 17 February 2012 and filed:-

1. by Solomon Harris on behalf of Fiona Moseley, Crusader International Management (Cayman) Ltd" Horse Whisper Ltd" and Exbury Holdings Ltd, (the "Solomon Harris Intended Witnesses") dated 1 and 7 March 2012; and
2. by Campbells on behalf of Fidelity Bank (Cayman) Limited, Keith High, Western International Trust Company Limited, Rurik Trust Company (International) Limited, Roger Hendrickson and Centennial Capital Inc, (the "Campbells Intended Witnesses") dated 1 March 2012;


(together the "Summonses") be heard together on Wednesday, 8 August to Friday, 10 August 2012;

AND IT APPEARING that the parties hereto consent to the making of this Order as evidenced by their respective signatures below;

BY CONSENT IT IS ORDERED AND DIRECTED THAT:

1. Full Skeleton Arguments and any supporting evidence of the Solomon Harris Intended Witnesses and the Campbells Intended Witnesses be filed and served by Friday, 15 June 2012.
2. Full Skeleton Argument and any supporting evidence of the Plaintiff in opposition to the Summonses be filed and served by Friday, 13 July 2012.
3. Any Skeleton Argument of the Solomon Harris Intended Witnesses and/or the Campbells Intended Witnesses in reply be filed and served by Tuesday, 31 July 2012
4. A case memorandum shall be prepared and agreed as far as possible, the case memorandum to include a dramatis personae, a list of issues and a procedural history, with such case memorandum to be filed by Tuesday, 31 July 2012.
5. Preparation of the hearing bundle shall be completed in accordance with the FSD Guide by not later than Tuesday, 31 July 2012.
6. The estimated length of the hearing is 2 days. The Court will require 1 day's pre-reading.
7. Save as varied by subsequent order, the procedures and processes in the FSD Guide are to be followed.
8. Costs in the application.
9. There be liberty to apply.


