SUPERVISION ORDER

UPON reading the Petition presented pursuant to Section 124 of the Companies Law (2011 Revision) on 22 June 2012 by Mark Longbottom and Jess Shakespeare in their capacity as Joint Voluntary Liquidators of Sytrarb Fund (“the Company”), the First Affidavit of Mr. Longbottom sworn on 20 June 2012 and the First Affidavit of Mr. Shakespeare sworn on 21 June 2012

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that the Petitioners complied with the requirements of paragraph 2 of the Order for Directions made on 5 July 2012 and that no creditor or shareholder of the Company has given notice of intention to appear at the hearing of the petition due take place on 6 August 2012

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that the Petitioners are both qualified insolvency practitioners who satisfy the residency, independence and insurance requirements of the Insolvency Practitioners’ Regulations.

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that it can properly make an order pursuant to CWR Order 15, rule 5(1) without the need for any hearing.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:


- (1) The liquidation of the Company continue under the supervision of the Court.
- (2) Mr Mark Longbottom and Mr Jess Shakespeare, both of Kinetic Partners (Cayman) Limited, 42 North Church Street, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, KY1-1104, are hereby appointed as joint official liquidators (“JOLs”) of the Company.
- (3) The JOLs shall not be required to give security for their appointment.
- (4) In addition to the powers prescribed in Part II of the Third Schedule to the Companies Law (2011 Revision) which are exercisable without sanction of this Court, the JOLs may also without further sanction or intervention from this Court exercise the following powers set out in Part I of the Third Schedule to the Companies Law:
 - i. The power to sell any of the Company’s property by public auction or private contract with power to transfer the whole of it to any person or to sell the same in parcels;
 - ii. The power to engage staff (whether or not as employees of the Company) to assist them in the performance of their functions; and
 - iii. The power to engage attorneys and other professionally qualified persons to assist them in the performance of their functions.

and for the avoidance of doubt the powers bestowed on the JOLs may be exercised by them within and outside the Cayman Islands.



- (5) The Petitioners' costs of this petition shall be paid out of the assets of the Company as an expense of the liquidation.
