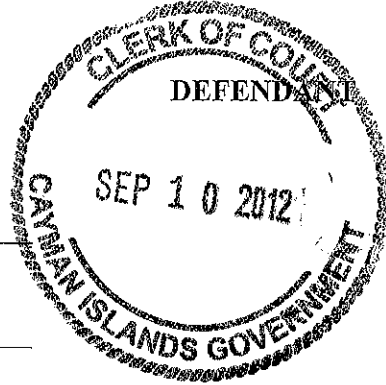
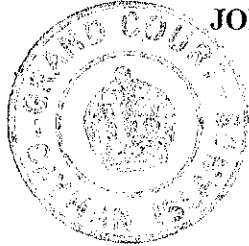

WRIT OF SUMMONS

TO: John B. McLean Jr. of PO Box 597, Grand Cayman. KY1-1602, Cayman Islands

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495 G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

ISSUED this 10th day of September 2012.

NOTE – This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is a Bank carrying on business at its branch at Elgin Avenue, Grand Cayman and the Defendant is a customer of the Plaintiff.
2. The Defendant is indebted to the Plaintiff on his Loan Account #014-15042 in the sum of CI\$34,148 being the outstanding principal balance on the account.
3. Pursuant to the loan agreement between the Plaintiff and the Defendant dated 10 August 2009, the said sum is payable on demand together with interest from the date the account became delinquent, on 3 January 2012, at an agreed rate of 3% above CI Dollar Prime Rate.
4. The total amount of interest claimed as at the date of these proceedings is CI\$935.01 and interest will continue to accrue until payment of the debt at a daily rate of CI\$6.09.
5. The Plaintiff made a written demand by letter from its attorneys dated 13 August 2012 but the Defendant has failed to repay the sum outstanding or any part of it.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS AGAINST THE DEFENDANT:-

1. Payment of the said sum of CI\$34,148.01.
2. Interest on the said sum as aforesaid at the rate of 3% above CI Dollar Prime Rate per annum, a daily sum of CI\$6.09, from the date the account became delinquent (3 January 2012) until the date of commencement of these proceedings in the sum of CI\$971.55 and continuing at the daily rate of CI\$6.09.
3. Late payment fees in the sum of CI\$175.00
4. The Plaintiff's costs to be assessed if agreed.
5. Further or other relief.
