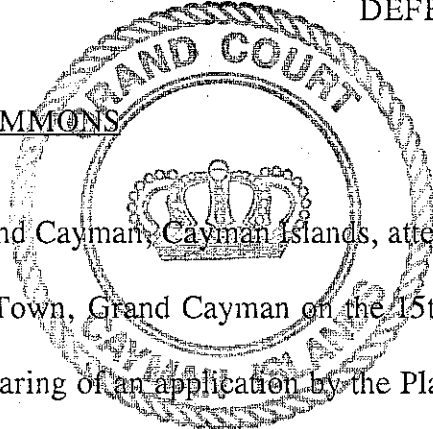

ORIGINATING SUMMONS



LET THE DEFENDANT of the Tower Building, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 15th day of May 1997, at 2:30 o'clock in the afternoon on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff c/o Orren Merren & Company, Attorneys-at-Law, P.O: Box 481G, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands that:

1. The Plaintiff herein be restored to the Register of Companies upon payment of the sum of CI\$2,080.00, together with such other dues payable to the Registrar of Companies and thereupon the Plaintiff company shall be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck from the Register of Companies.
2. That a duly sealed copy of the Order be served upon the Registrar of Companies who shall thereupon advertise this Order in the Cayman Islands Gazette.
3. That such other order may be made in the premises as the Court shall deem fit.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this summons on him counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office.

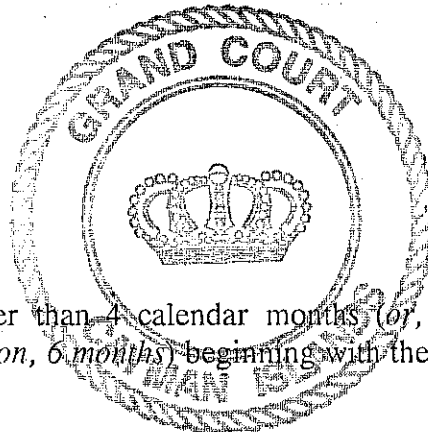

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE  
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of *Acknowledgment of Service* should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

***Notes for Guidance***

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (*the name stated on the Originating Summons*)".
4. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian *ad litem*.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.
