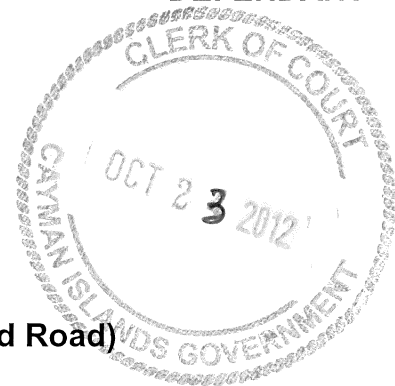

Within [14 days] after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Note – This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (*or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months*) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM


1. The Plaintiff's claim is for damages for assault on the Plaintiff by the Defendant in July 2012 totalling CI\$4,390.00 for loss of earnings and medical expenses together with interest at the statutory rate.

2. The Plaintiff also seeks an order that:
 - (a) The Defendant be restrained by himself, his servants or agents from assaulting, molesting, harassing or otherwise interfering with the Plaintiff; and

 - (b) The Defendant be restrained from entering or attempting to enter the Plaintiff's place of residence at #81 Eldon Street, North Sound, New Lands, Grand Cayman;

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. The sum of CI\$4,390.00 as hereinbefore set out
2. Interest at the statutory rate
3. Costs to be agreed or taxed
