
BY THIS ORIGINATING SUMMONS, which is issued on the application of the Plaintiff, HSBC INTERNATIONAL TRUSTEE LIMITED ("**Trustee**"), Level 13, 1 Queen's Road Central, Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, the Plaintiff seeks:

- 1 Directions and orders as to whether any, and if so which, persons should be joined as a party or parties to these proceedings or be served with notice of these proceedings;
- 2 That the Trustee be authorised to exercise the powers conferred by Clause 5 of the Trust in order to appoint out assets of the Trust to:
 - 2.1 Timothy Wynhun Yeung;

- 2.2 Andrew Wyn Chan Yeung;
- 2.3 Kavan Yeung; and
- 2.4 Tessa Yeung.
- 3 Alternatively, the Trustee be authorised to exercise the powers conferred by clause 9 of the Trust in order to appoint assets to a new trust.
- 4 That all necessary or proper consequential directions be given.
- 5 That provision be made for the retention or payment out of the Trust's assets held by the Trustee of the costs of these proceedings on an indemnity basis of the Trustee.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 28 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.
