

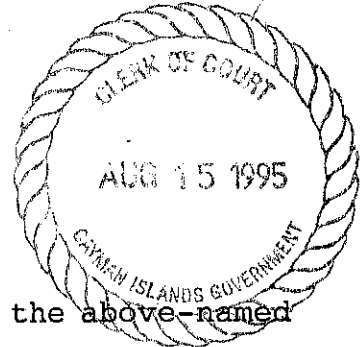

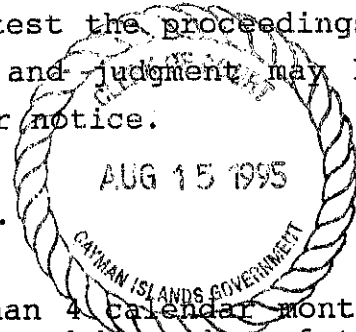


THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledge of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. In or around March 1992 the Defendant took up occupancy of a property belonging to the Plaintiff at Windsor Park, George Town, Grand Cayman known as Block 14E, Parcel 213, George Town South ("the Property").
2. It was expressly and/or impliedly agreed between the Plaintiff and the Defendant that the Defendant would pay a fair rent throughout the term of his occupancy of the Property.
3. The Property is 2 bedroomed apartment.
4. The Plaintiff claims and is entitled to receive from the Defendant a fair rent of CI\$400 a month for each and every month that the Defendant was in possession of the Property.
5. That the Defendant vacated the Property in around August 1994.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. 29 months rent in the total sum of CI\$11,600.
2. Interest thereon pursuant to Section 34 of the Judicature Law at the rate of 8%% per annum for such period as is deemed just.
3. Costs.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgement of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of CI\$11,600 (and the sum of CI\$600 for costs) further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his Attorney.]
