- 1 Pursuant to the Arbitration Law, 2012, the Plaintiff be permitted to enforce against the First, Second and Third Defendants an interim award dated 26 October 2012 of arbitrator Carlos J. Bianchi appointed in Arbitration Case No. 50 503 T 00481 12 under the American Arbitration Association International Centre for Dispute Resolution Rules pursuant to an agreement for arbitration dated 28 February 2008 between the Plaintiff and the First Defendant and an agreement for arbitration dated 31 July 2011 between the Plaintiff and the Second Defendant.
- 2 That the Court make such further or alternative orders or directions as it sees fit.
- 3 That the First, Second and Third Defendants be jointly and severally liable to pay the costs of this Originating Summons and of any judgment which may be entered hereunder.

If any of the First, Second or Third Defendants do not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.
