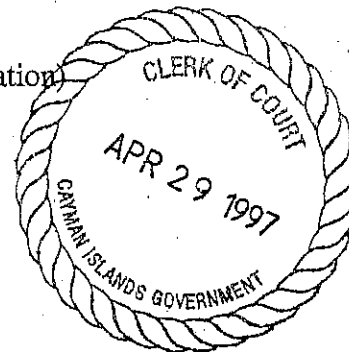

EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

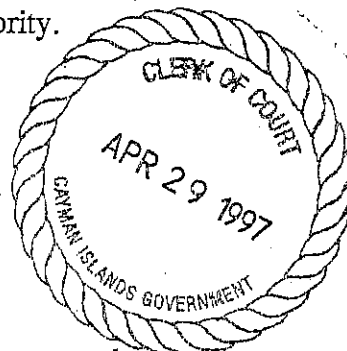
LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 27th day of May, 1997 upon an application by Christopher Johnson and Robert Jenkinson of Coopers & Lybrand, P. O. Box 219GT, Butterfield House, George Town, Grand Cayman, in their capacity as Joint Liquidators of Transworld Bank & Trust Limited ("Transworld") for the following orders:

1. An Order pursuant to Section 149 of the Companies Law (1995 Revision) that the liquidation of Transworld continue subject to the supervision of the Court.
2. An Order for Directions as to -
 - a. the future conduct of the actions pending between the Bank and Banco Economico S.A. in the Grand Court and the Supreme Court of New York;
 - b. the way in which the said actions should be financed; and
 - c. the way in which the liquidators' future fees and expenses should be financed.
3. An Order approving the Liquidators' fees and expenses incurred to date.
4. Such further orders and directions as the Court thinks fit.
5. The order that the costs of this application be treated as expenses of the liquidation to be paid out of Transworld's assets.
