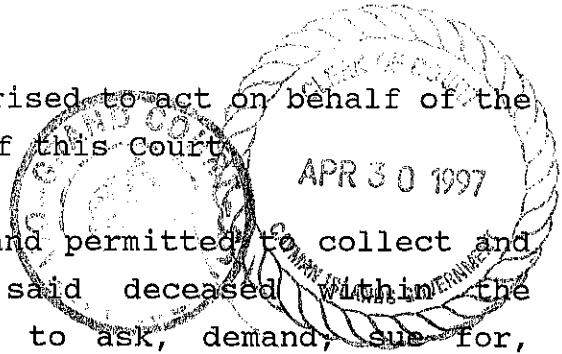

1. David A. Chenkin ("the Curator") of Frank, Effman, Weinberg & Black, 8000 Peters Road, Plantation, Florida 33324, U.S.A.,

having been appointed as Curator of the estate of Joseph Aloysius Kelleher, deceased ("the Estate") pursuant to Orders of the Circuit Court in and for Broward County, Florida, U.S.A, in File No. 95-1654, dated 6th July 1995 and 2nd November 1995 (copies of which are annexed hereto) be and hereby is recognised as such in the Cayman Islands by this Court.

2. That the Curator is hereby authorised to act on behalf of the Estate within the jurisdiction of this Court.
3. That the Curator is authorised and permitted to collect and preserve the assets of the said deceased within the jurisdiction of this Court and to ask, demand, sue for, recover, and receive the said assets for the purpose of turning over and delivering them to the legally appointed and qualified Personal Representative of the Estate (when such Personal Representative is duly appointed).
4. Alternatively, that the Curator be appointed as a Receiver over such of the assets of the said deceased as may be within the jurisdiction of this Court.
5. That the Defendant do forthwith disclose to the Curator all information in its possession concerning any assets of the said deceased.
6. That the Defendant do forthwith deliver up to the Curator all such assets in its possession, custody or control, including (without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) the contents of a safety deposit box numbered 75 and rented in the name of the said deceased ("the Property").
7. That the Curator be deemed to be the "relevant principal" within the meaning of the Confidential Relationships (Preservation) Law (As Amended) and that he may be treated as

LETTERS OF CURATORSHIP

JOSEPH ALOYSIUS KELLEHER, a resident of Broward County Florida, died on January 29, 1995 owning assets in the State of Florida; and



WHEREAS, it appears to the undersigned Circuit Judge that a curator is necessary to take charge of the assets of the decedent in order that they may be well preserved, and administered, in accordance with the orders of this court, until a Personal Representative is appointed; and

WHEREAS, DAVID CHENKIN, the curator appointed by order of this court, has performed all acts prerequisite to the issuance of letters of a curatorship as the legally qualified curator of the estate of Joseph Aloysius Kelleher.

NOW, therefore, I, LARRY SEIDLIN, the undersigned Circuit Judge, do grant to DAVID CHENKIN the curatorship of the estate, until a Personal Representative can be appointed, with full power to collect and preserve the assets that belonged to the decedent in his lifetime and at the time of his death, and to ask, demand, sue for, recover, and receive the assets for the purpose of turning over and delivering them to the legally appointed and qualified Personal Representative of the estate of Joseph Aloysius Kelleher; and all persons in possessions of the assets of the decedent are ordered and directed to deliver them to DAVID CHENKIN, as Curator.
