

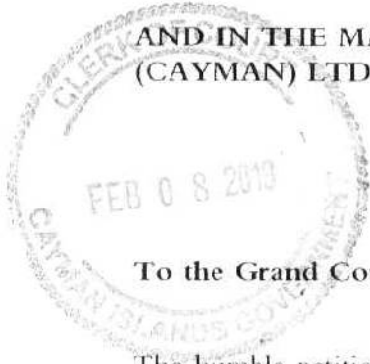

WINDING UP PETITION

To the Grand Court



The humble petition of Appleby (Cayman) Ltd, of Clifton House, PO Box 190, Grand Cayman KY1-1104, Cayman Islands, (the "**Petitioner**") shows that:

1. Tropical Rent A Car and Tours (Cayman) Ltd (the "**Company**"), is an ordinary resident company which was incorporated on the 14 October 1993 (company number 50933), having previously traded under the name Dollar Rent A Car.
2. The registered office of the Company is Cayman National Trust Co Ltd. which is situated at 62 Forum Lane, Camana Bay. P.O. Box 30239 Seven Mile Beach, Grand Cayman KY1-1201, Cayman Islands.
3. As far as the Petitioner is aware, the Company only carries on business in the Cayman Islands and, while trading as Dollar Rent A Car, it held a Trade and Business License up until 31 December 2011.
4. The share capital of the Company is US\$50,000 divided into 50,000 shares of a value of \$1 each, of which only 100 shares have been issued, as of the last known Annual Return on 30 June 2011.
5. Debbi Peart holds 60 shares in the Company and Ralph Smith holds 40 shares in the Company.

6. On 21 November 2012, the Petitioner served a statutory demand on the Company for payment of debts totaling US\$10,529.73 in respect of unpaid legal fees incurred by the Company.
7. The Company has neglected to pay the Petitioner the sum demanded or any sum within 3 weeks succeeding such demand.
8. The Company is unable to pay its debts, and should be wound up pursuant to section 92(d) of the Law.

Your Petitioner therefore humbly prays that:-

1. The Company be wound up in accordance with the Law.
2. Russell Smith be appointed as official liquidators of the Company.
3. The Liquidators shall not be required to give security for their appointment.
4. The Liquidators be authorised to exercise any of the powers conferred on them by the Court pursuant to Section 110(2) and Parts I and II of the Third Schedule of the Companies Law (2012 Revision) without the further sanction or intervention of the Court.
5. The Liquidators be authorised to do any act or things considered by them to be necessary or desirable in connection with the liquidation of the Company and the winding-up of its affairs and to prevent the dissipation of the Company's assets.
6. No suit, action or other proceeding shall be proceeded with or commenced against the Company except with the leave of the Court and subject to such terms as the Court may impose.
7. No disposition of the Company's property by or with the authority of the Liquidators in carrying out their duties and functions and exercise of their powers

under this Order shall be voided by virtue of section 99 of the Companies Law (2012 Revision).

8. The Liquidators be at liberty to appoint counsel, attorneys, and professional advisors, whether in the Cayman Islands or elsewhere as they may consider necessary to advise and assist them in the performance of their duties and on such terms as they may think fit and to remunerate them out of the assets of the Company.
9. The Liquidators and their staff be remunerated out of the assets of the Company at their usual customary rates.
10. The Liquidators be at liberty to apply generally.
11. The costs of the Petitioner of and incidental to the Petition be paid out of the assets of the Company as an expense of the liquidation, such costs to be taxed if not agreed with the Liquidators.
12. Such further or other relief be granted as the Court deems appropriate.
